LOCATION OF INCIDENT/CRIME

North Parking Structure, South Parking Structure, UC DAVIS Campus

SUMMARY OF CRIME/INCIDENT

On 12-09-2017, officers responded to calls for service in the North and South Parking Structures regarding several vehicle burglaries. Unknown suspect(s) broke vehicle windows and took items, many in plain view from outside the vehicle. The time frame developed from victim statements indicates the thefts occurred on 12-09-2017 from 1100 hours to 1400 hours.

CAMPUS COMMUNITY SAFETY TIPS FROM UC DAVIS POLICE

- Always lock your vehicle and store valuables out of sight.
- Be aware of location and situation that will make you vulnerable to crime, such as alley and dark parking lots.
- Avoid people and situations that make you nervous – trust your instincts!
- Whenever possible, travel with a friend.
- Stay in well-lighted areas as much as possible.
- Walk close to the curb and avoid doorways, bushes and alleys where someone could hide.
- Walk confidently and at a steady pace, making eye contact with people when walking.
- If you have a backpack or bag, carry it securely against you. Although a purse-snatcher's intent is to steal the purse, your personal safety may require you to give it up.
- Use UC Davis Police Safe Rides after hours on campus by calling 530-754-COPS or download our free smart phone application (TAPRIDE)
- If you ever feel you or others are in danger, call 9-1-1.
