### **SUMMARY OF CRIME/INCIDENT**

On 10-02-16 at 12:46 PM, UC Davis Police was made aware of a suspicious circumstance that occurred on campus at the above address.

On 10-02-16 between 01:00 am to 01:10 am, an unknown male subject claiming to be an Uber driver, picked up three females at the above address. He dropped two females at their residences on campus. The third female was driven to her residence at West Village. The male Uber driver insisted on a kiss as payment for the ride but unlocked the door when a Police Department Safe-Rides vehicle drove past him. The female exited the car and fled to her apartment.

**Subject:** The driver was described as a male of unknown race, between 25 to 35 years of age with curly black hair, wearing glasses and spoke with an accent.

**Vehicle:** The vehicle was described a four door black or dark vehicle.

- Always be alert to your surroundings.

- Uber Safety Tips:
  - Verify the identity of the driver and their car before you get in.
  - Wait inside for your ride to come.
  - Keep in touch with friends or family.
  - Take note of the driver's rating on the app.
- Avoid people and situations that make you nervous – trust your instincts!
- Whenever possible, travel with a friend.
- Walk close to the curb and avoid doorways, bushes and alleys where someone could hide.
- Walk confidently and at a steady pace, making eye contact with people when walking.
- Use UC Davis Police Safe Rides after hours on campus by calling 530-754-COPS or download our free smart phone application (TAPRIDE)
- If you ever feel you or others are in danger, call 9-1-1.
