### LOCATION OF INCIDENT/CRIME

Dairy Road at the Southeast corner of The Pavilion; 211 PC, 243.4(e)(1) PC- Two counts

### SUMMARY OF CRIME/INCIDENT

On 5/25/17 at approximately 0210 hrs. a male suspect displayed what appeared to be a toy gun to three female victims as they walked southbound on the Dairy Road bike path, near the southeast corner of The Pavilion. The suspect asked the victims to do something, sexually battered two of the victims and took one victim's cell phone. The suspect was last seen running northbound towards the Activities and Recreation Center. The victims were not physically injured. The suspect did not make any verbal threats to harm the victims and did not point the toy gun at them. Victim's property was recovered.

This crime is currently unsolved and an investigation is ongoing. Anyone with information about this or similar incidents should call UCDPD at 530-754-COPS (2677). **Suspect:** White male, early 20s, 5'9", skinny, black hair with 1/4-1/2" on top as if growing back from a shaved head. Wearing long sleeve white t-shirt with black sleeves, black jeans, and carrying a navy blue drawstring type backpack. Gun displayed was described as a small black shiny handgun.

### CAMPUS COMMUNITY SAFETY TIPS FROM UC DAVIS POLICE

- Always be alert to your surroundings.
- See Something, Say Something. Report suspicious activity to UC Davis Police (530) 754-COPS
- Be aware of location and situation that will make you vulnerable to crime, such as alley and dark parking lots.
- Avoid people and situations that make you nervous – trust your instincts!
- Whenever possible, travel with a friend.
- Stay in well-lighted areas as much as possible.
- Walk close to the curb and avoid doorways, bushes and alleys where someone could hide.
- Walk confidently and at a steady pace, making eye contact with people when walking.
- Use UC Davis Police Safe Rides after hours on campus by calling 530-754-COPS or download our free smart phone application (TAPRIDE)
