The UC Davis Police Department is a repository for lost and found items at the Davis and Sacramento Campuses. California Civil Code sections 2080.1 and 2080.6 provide the law for regulations for the care, restitution, sale or destruction of unclaimed property in its possession. Until recently, we would accept any items submitted.

Effective *December 1, 2008*, the UC Davis Police Department will change their Lost and Found acceptance policy and will only accept the following items:

- Cameras
- Cash
- Cell phones
- Checkbooks/checks
- Credit cards/ATM cards
- Eyeglasses
- Jewelry (rings, bracelets, necklaces, watches and earrings, etc.)
- Laptops
- Passports
- Purses
- Wallets
- Backpacks containing identifying information or any of the above listed items

All found University keys should be immediately turned over to the Lock Shop. The UC Davis Police Department will no longer accept university keys.

**All other items will not be accepted. Please do not drop off any items that are not on this list.**

Found items can be retrieved from the Davis and Sacramento Campuses Monday through Thursday, 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. except during holidays. You may refer anyone who has lost an item to visit the Police website at <http://police.ucdavis.edu>, click on the Lost and Found Link, and then use the search tool to view found items. Found items are held at the Police Department for 90 days.
