TIMELY WARNING: THREATENING BEHAVIOR

UC Davis Police has received information that a University of California, Davis student has made a general threat to cause harm to other students on campus. This student has made specific threats towards specific individuals who in turn have been notified by campus police. The student making the threats has been identified as Kenneth Scott Earl who resides in Miller Hall. Kenneth Earl has been suspended from attending class at UC Davis and is currently not on campus.

Due to current circumstances surrounding this case, more detailed information is not available at this time.

THE UNIVERSITY WOULD LIKE TO REMIND STUDENTS:

- Most perpetrators choose a victim they know
- California law and the UC Davis Student Code of Conduct prohibit assault or threatening behavior
- It is your responsibility to report suspicious activity on campus
- Threatening to harm another is a crime
