SUMMARY OF CRIME/INCIDENT

On 10/14/18 at about 1230am, victim was at a party at the above address. Three males approached the victim and demanded his property. One suspect had a handgun in his hand near his waistband. The victim gave them his property and all three males left the room they were in. Victim did not see if/how they exited the residence.

Suspect(s): All three described as Hispanic males, all about 5'8" tall, late 20s, wearing dark hoodies.

This crime is currently unsolved and an investigation is being completed by the City of Davis Police Department. Anyone with information about this or similar incidents should call Davis Police Department at 530-747-5400.

CAMPUS COMMUNITY SAFETY TIPS FROM UC DAVIS POLICE

Always be alert to your surroundings.

- Be aware of location and situation that will make you vulnerable to crime, such as alley and dark parking lots.
- Avoid people and situations that make you nervous – trust your instincts!
- Stay in well-lighted areas as much as possible.
- Walk close to the curb and avoid doorways, bushes and alleys where someone could hide.
- Walk confidently and at a steady pace, making eye contact with people when walking.

- If you ever feel you or others are in danger, call 9-1-1.
