COFFEE SHOP ROBBERY SERIES

UCDPD has been notified of multiple laptop robberies in the Davis area coffee shops. The most recent robbery was at Peet's Coffee, 231 E Street in Davis, on Tuesday Sept. 25th.

All of these robberies have been perpetrated by young males. In each case the suspects entered a coffee shop, looked around, and began grabbing laptop computers. In some cases, the suspects grabbed computers out of the hands of people sitting at tables conducting business or studying. Some victims attempted to retain their property and the suspects responded with violence. At least two victims suffered minor injuries.

Davis PD believe these crimes may be related and are part of a regional trend. Davis PD ask that people review the attached surveillance footage and report any knowledge about these crimes to the Davis Police Department, (530) 747-5400.

September 23, 2018:

Robbery occurred at Starbucks, 403 Mace Bl.

August 14, 2018:

Robbery occurred at Temple Coffee, 239 G Street.
