LOCATION OF INCIDENT/CRIME

Lot 47 UC Davis Campus, 211- Robbery

SUMMARY OF CRIME/INCIDENT

On 9/30/18 at 0410 a.m., unknown suspects drove into Lot 47 at 601 La Rue Road. Victims were in the parking lot, outside their vehicle. Suspect(s) approached victims, stated they had a gun, and ordered them to “drop” their property. Victims saw the outline of a gun in suspect #2’s waistband. Victims complied and put their property down. Suspect #1 punched one female victim in the face several times. Suspect #1 collected the victim’s property and both fled the area in a vehicle.

Suspect(s): #1- African American male, 5’8” to 6’, mid 20s, all black clothing, black hoodie, medium build

#2- African American male, 5’10” to 6’, mid 20s, black hoodie and pants, thicker build

Vehicle: Black Dodge Charger or Challenger, 1990s or newer model

CAMPUS COMMUNITY SAFETY TIPS FROM UC DAVIS POLICE

- Always be alert to your surroundings.
- See Something, Say Something. Report suspicious activity to UC Davis Police (530) 754-COPS
- Report criminal activity (such as break-in, intruder, robbery, assault) immediately to 9-1-1 or for non-emergency Situations on campus, to UCDPD at (530) 754-COPS (2677)
- Be aware of location and situation that will make you vulnerable to crime, such as alley and dark parking lots.
- Avoid people and situations that make you nervous – trust your instincts!
- Whenever possible, travel with a friend.
- Stay in well-lighted areas as much as possible. Do not walk alone late at night.
- Use UC Davis Police Safe Rides after hours on campus by calling 530-754-COPS or download our free smart phone application (TAPRIDE)
- Walk close to the curb and avoid doorways, bushes and alleys where someone could hide.
- Walk confidently and at a steady pace, making eye contact with people when walking.
- If you have a backpack or bag, carry it securely against you. Although a thief’s intent is to steal the item, your personal safety may require you to give it up.
- If you ever feel you or others are in danger, call 9-1-1.
